INVITATION: You are cordially invited to participate in the 2009 Wyoming Governor's Cup Open Regatta hosted by the Casper Boat Club (CBC).

ELIGIBILITY/FLEETS/CLASSES

Open to all Keel, Centerboard and Multi-Hull sailboats.

Fleet/Class racing will be available to those Classes registering four (4) or more boats. Classes not able to make a fleet will race in their appropriate Handicap Fleet; a PHRF fleet, for keel boats; a Portsmouth Fleet for Centerboard boats and a separate handicap for multihull boats. For Non S.A.I.L. PHRF members, ratings will be determined by the OA/PRO and are not subject to appeal. Classes may be started together but will be scored separately.

RULES AND EQUIPMENT

This regatta will be governed by the current 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by this NOR and by the regatta Sailing Instructions. Sailing instructions will be available during registration & check in. The Casper Boat Club is the Organizing Authority.

SCORING The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), will apply with the following modifications:

- DNS/OCS/DNC = Starters +1,
- DNF/RET/RAF = Finishers + 1,
- DSQ = Entries + 2.

All races will be scored and there will be no throw outs. One race shall constitute a regatta.

TROPHIES Trophies will be awarded to the winning helmsman in each class with 5 or more boats will receive trophies for first, second and third places.
